

Voting for Proposition A does **NOT** create new taxes, even though the wording makes it sound like it will.

See below for clarification of the ballot wording.

THIS IS A TAX INCREASE

RATIFYING THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE OF \$0.9580 IN THE ABILENE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE CURRENT YEAR, A RATE THAT WILL RESULT IN AN INCREASE OF 14.53% IN MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS TAX REVENUE FOR THE DISTRICT FOR THE CURRENT YEAR AS COMPARED TO THE PRECEDING YEAR, WHICH IS AN ADDITIONAL \$3,712,829.

The Texas Legislature requires this language.

BUT because AISD had voted to reduce the current rate by 8 cents, the net result for AISD households will be a tax decrease.

Voting 'FOR' gets the tax decrease AND unlocks \$10 million annually for AISD from the STATE.

Remember, because AISD voted for a previous 8 cents tax decrease, even this rate results in a net decrease of our current tax.

With the decrease this shifts the \$3+ million to AISD's Maintenance & Operations Fund to teachers' salaries, teacher retention. classroom resources. student programs, etc. AND unlocks \$10+million every year from the State, for AISD.
